STEM Ambassadors are people working or studying in a STEM field, that are PVG-checked by STEM Learning, who give up their time to help demonstrate the value of STEM subjects and careers.

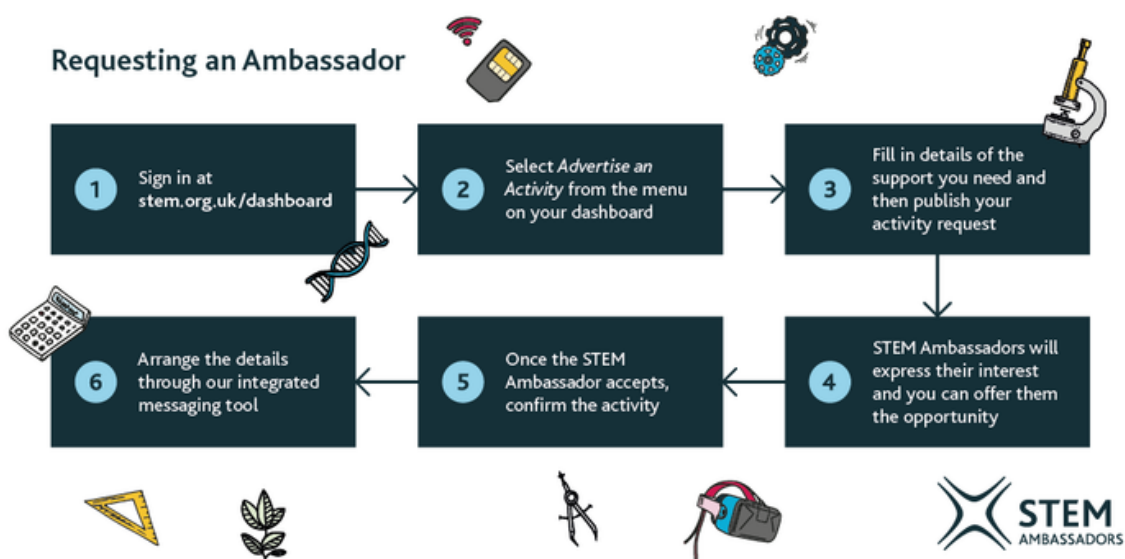

ACCESSING THE PROGRAMME
